

Responses to frequently asked questions:

1. Any school closure will require the District to add a day to the end of the school year to meet the required 180 school days per Arizona state law. Further information will be provided to parents if this situation occurs.
2. FUSD teachers are participating in a statewide movement to increase funding for K-12 education. Our local teacher leaders assure us their actions are not directed at the FUSD community, Board, or Administration.
3. There are rumors about a walkout beginning tomorrow, April 20. We have been reassured by leaders of the movement that there is no walkout planned for Friday. Statewide polling is continuing through the end of the business day today. We hope to know more in the next few days and will keep you informed.
4. We are not supporting or encouraging teachers to walk out. We have sent them facts related to the Governor's proposal and working to get answers to their questions.
5. It is our intent to proceed with graduation ceremonies as scheduled. That assumes students have met all requirements.
