



SB 1118 technical correction; heritage fund; audit (Gowan)

Provisions:

- Expands eligibility to receive a scholarship from a STO to include students who:
 - Were homeschooled before enrolling in a private school.
 - Moved to Arizona from out of state before enrolling in a private school.
 - Participated in an empowerment scholarship account (ESA) and did not renew the account or accept the scholarship in order to accept a STO scholarship or grant.
- Increases the cap on scholarship amount from \$4,200 to \$5,600 per year for K-8 students and preschool students with disabilities.
- Increases the cap on scholarship amount from \$6,900 to \$7,500 per year for students in grades 9-12.
- Establishes that in each year after 2021, the limit amount for a scholarship shall be increased by \$200, rather than \$100.
