

Interested in running to represent your county on the ASBA Board of Directors as County Director? A candidate must be a seated board member at the time of election and, if elected, throughout their term. In addition, candidates must commit to fulfilling all County Director responsibilities. Learn more here.

### **Process for Running for County Director**

Anyone wishing to run for an open County Director seat must notify ASBA of their intent to run a minimum of one-week prior to the meeting by emailing [ksisk@azsba.org](mailto:ksisk@azsba.org). Candidates may also run from the floor as a write-in candidate.

Candidates will be provided time at the meeting to give a speech of up to three-minutes. If no candidates step forward to run, the ASBA Board of Directors will appoint per ASBA bylaws a County Director prior to the start of the term of office.

### **County Director Elections and Voting Delegates**

County Director elections will take place in the following counties this year: Santa Cruz, Pima, La Paz, Mohave, Maricopa, Yavapai, Coconino, and Gila.

Delegates and the County Director Election Process Voting will take place electronically during the meeting. Each member district board in the county is entitled to one vote. Each board must appoint in advance a delegate (and an alternate, if desired) who may cast the board's vote for County Director.

If your board already named a delegate for the ASBA Delegate Assembly, that same person can remain your delegate for this vote as well. If you did not select a delegate for the Delegate Assembly or you would like to name a different delegate, please select one for the County Meeting and let ASBA know who it is no later than one week prior to your county meeting using this [link](#).

### **Sample Agenda Language**
